



PARANORMAL 102 – EVP EXPLORATIONS

Course Description:

You explore how emotion, fatigue, expectation, and fear alter perception. Understanding your own psychological reactions is essential for removing bias and preventing misinterpretation. You learn how to perform self-checks before and during investigation.

Module 3 — Residual Loop Behavior:

Residual hauntings follow predictable cycles. This module teaches you how to identify replay patterns, environmental triggers, and historical imprints. You learn how to distinguish loops from intelligent manifestations by mapping timing, frequency, and behavioral consistency.

Module 4 — Intelligent Response Structure:

Intelligent activity demonstrates awareness and reaction. You learn how to identify responsive timing, multi-sensory engagement, and conversational patterns. This module shows you how to test responsiveness without influencing results.

Module 5 — Environmental Mapping:

You learn how to create environmental maps that track temperature pockets, EMF spikes, shadow pathways, and pressure zones. Mapping creates reliable investigative predictability and reveals hidden behavioral structures.

Module 6 — Emotional Atmosphere Tracking:

Emotional presence is a signature of intelligent manifestation. You learn how to read emotional shifts in the room, document their timing, and correlate them with environmental and visual anomalies.

Module 7 — Multi-Layer Contamination Control:

Environmental contamination occurs across sound, EMF, temperature, airflow, electronics, and investigator movement. You learn how to eliminate false positives by controlling each layer step by step.

Module 8 — Shadow Variant Analysis:

You learn to differentiate peripheral shadows, corridor crossers, structural mimics, and reactive shadows. Each has unique movement styles and environmental dependencies. This module strengthens your ability to eliminate natural causes.

Module 9 — Apparition Structure & Stability:

Not all apparitions behave alike. This module explores partial forms, flicker-phase forms, stable forms, and cross-environmental manifestations, teaching you how to classify stability and density traits.

Module 10 — Evidence Integration Fundamentals:

This final module shows you how to integrate EVP, EMF, temperature logs, emotional data, and visual reports into one unified analytical process. You learn how to identify correlation patterns and eliminate coincidence.
